Discussion and possible action on plan to amend IP scheme, make changes and schedule dates for implementation

A small team of IT officials met to continue a working discussion regarding the ARIN databases and IP addresses.

The discussed having DeVore enter the IP addresses in the ARIN database at the county DNS servers for point of record. It was determined none of the members need reverse DNS, except for NEICAC that uses county IP address in the Smith Building.

Smith will verify if reverse DNS is still needed.

It was decided that the IP scheme moves may begin in early December with Smith and Albert coordinating the move.

In keeping with the original MetroNet Fiber architecture, the team discussed putting the original anchor members on their own and separate fiber strands rather than continue to use the common fiber strand pairs, especially for Internet connections.
