

City of Decorah Street Committee Meeting

The City of Decorah Street Committee met on Monday, February 18, 2019 at approximately 6:30pm immediately following the adjournment of the regular council meeting. Chair Ross Hadley called the meeting to order.

Discussion and update regarding projects

a) Oneota Drive Bridge Replacement Project

Bird review final bridge designs with the committee. Jeff Schug walked through the final design and Bhooshan Karnik reviewed the bid time lines. Schug noted there is a new paint advisory out from the Iowa DOT and it is recommended for bike lane surfaces.

Bird also took a moment to ask if anyone knew the ownership of the cable hanging under the bridge. No known utility was claiming the cable.

There were no other questions or discussion on the bridge.

b) Review 2019 Street Projects

Hadley opened the discussion by distributing a list of proposed projects for 2019.

There was discussion on improving the intersection at Main Street and Court Street. Brill reviewed some initial plan designs. The committee liked the idea of improving the intersection. There was also discussion on involving the Historic Preservation Commission in review of the design since the improvements will impact the brick streets. Bird and Brill noted they would contact the HPC commission.

The committee agreed to keep the upper Co-op parking lot in the list of projects.

The full list included:

Steyer Bridge deck and railing

Broadway alley improvement

Court Street and Main Street intersection and curb work

Broadway and Winnebago crosswalk and pedestrian work

Short Street, second half of the work started in 2017

Upper Co-op parking lot

Oneota Drive Bridge

2019 sidewalk improvement project
