Discussion and update regarding projects

a) Oneota Drive Bridge Replacement Project

Bird introduced Karnik and Schug and turned the meeting over to them for final review of bridge plans.

Karnik reviewed the timeline for bidding and work with the Iowa DOT. He noted the project is slated for a May 21st, 2019 bid letting date. He also noted the DOT will review and comment on the engineer's opinion of final costs prior to bidding and then also provide a review of the bid tabs after the bidding process.

It was discussed the project would most likely have a contract end date of November 30, 2019 rather than a working day contract.

It was verified that the street lights would be "by others" in the bid with the city working directly with Alliant Energy for those improvements. It was also discussed there would be two conduits running under and through the new bridge for future use.

Jeremy Brill raised several finer points in the plans regarding trees, grubbing, lights, and some of the detail on the cracking sealing of the Cut as proposed in the bid alternate. These items were discussed and details explained.

There was no other business and the meeting adjourned at 5:38pm.
