Ordinance 1261 amending Chapter 17 relating to storage containers was introduced and read for the second time. Motion by Luse, second by Schissel, to approve the second reading. Roll call vote. Voting aye: Luse, Schissel, Zittergruen, Hadley, Neal. Voting nay: Carlson. Motion carried.

Ordinance 1264 amending Chapters 2.16 and 2.48 of the City Code related to the status of the Chief of Police. Motion by Schissel, second by Luse, to approve the second reading. Chief Smutzler voiced concerns about the following language in the ordinance: "Be directly responsible to the council for the administration of municipal affairs as set forth in this chapter. All departments of the city shall report and be responsible to the city manager. The city manager has the power to prepare, adopt, and implement personnel and financial rules and procedures necessary for the conduct of all departments under the city manager's control so long as any such rule is consistent with the City Code and Iowa Law. The city manager retains sole discretion to resolve any conflict between policies of all departments of the city so long as the resolution of any such conflicts is consistent with City Code and Iowa law". He voiced concerns that department heads didn't realize this language was being proposed until this morning.

Councilperson Neal stated it should go back to committee for review and to give department heads the opportunity to speak to the language. Roll call vote. Voting aye: Schissel, Luse. Voting nay: Neal, Carlson, Zittergruen, Hadley. Motion failed. Second reading and ordinance fails.
