Special Meeting March 31, 2021-5:00pm Meeting Minutes

Electronic meeting pursuant to Iowa Code section 21.8 – In circumstances where such a meeting is impossible or impractical due to concerns about COVID-19 and social distancing for the safety of Council members and the public.

In support of Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds' proclamation declaring a State of Public Health Disaster Emergency the Decorah City Hall will have limited seating to remain under 50% capacity at required social distancing protocol during the March 8, 2021 Planning & Zoning Commission meeting. Access to the Chambers will be limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. However, the meeting will be made available electronically. The public will be able to hear and participate in the Commission meeting by calling:

Consider approval of new site layout re: 308 Sumner Avenue, Winneshiek County Ag Assoc. New 100' x 160' commercial building and a 30' south canopy extension.

Swanson reviewed the background notes and stated that on December 2nd, 2020 Winneshiek County Ag Association presented to Board of Adjustment requesting variance for permission to construct a new community building contrary to the C-5 district regulations and a special permit of the Zoning Code. (17.104.040,17.52.020, 17.32) Also requested were 3 variances of original building of 21,600 SF for a 5' front building setback from Sumner Ave, (40' req'd) and a reduction on the required parking stalls of 432 (1 stall per 50sf), and a special use permit for type of use contrary to the permitted uses in the C-5 zoning district.

Board approved on 12/2/2020.

The project was pulled from the December P&Z meeting agenda per AG Association request.

New proposed structure is 16,000 SF with a 30' canopy. 5' variance will still be utilized. New parking requirement of 320 stalls. (1 stall per 50SF)

Existing structures have been removed with plans to eliminate the last existing Bathroom structure prior to construction.

City Engineer Bril gave a brief statement in review of the site checklist as supporting documentation in regards to utility easements, and barrier free parking requirements with direct access needs.

Clarke called on Ron Hemesath to speak on behalf of the project.

Essa asked if possible locations of the BF parking had been determined

Hemesath gave possible locations but said the likely location would be on the northwest corner.

Clarke asked for info on the building structure (metal, AC? interior etc.)

Hemesath provided that the building was all based off donations given and would be a steel building, well insulated, have a catered kitchen and fully functional bathrooms.

Clarke commented that it would be a nice welcoming addition to the fair and to the city of Decorah.

Clarke called for commission discussion.

Commission had no further comments.

Clarke called for public comment.

No public comments were made.

Motion by Delaney and second by Klocke to recommend approval of the new Winneshiek County AG Association building.
Roll call vote: Ayes, unanimous.
Absent: Zook, Thompson
Motion passed.

Other business

In other business, Klocke raised the idea of changing the start time for meetings from 7:00pm to 5:30pm. The commission agreed to consider this for future meetings.

Delaney expressed concerns for an early start time in summer months.

The commission agreed to consider a time change at the April meeting.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:37pm
