Chair Hadley, Neal, Johnson, Schissel

Hadley called the meeting to order with Neal, Johnson, and Schissel attending.

Others attending: Mayor Borowski, City Manager Travis Goedken, City Clerk/Treasurer Wanda Hemesath, City Engineer Jeremy Brill, Asst. Police Chief Brent Parker, Councilperson Zittergruen, Councilperson Luse

1. FY23 Street Plan

Brill presented a proposed cost allocation for FY23 that focused on preventative maintenance and improved rideability (overlays, patching) and some curb and gutter. Hadley noted having FY23 serve as a “rest year” and build back the fund balance.

2. Snow Removal Code proposed changes

Discussion was had on the current snow removal operations and city code. Brill presented three options for consideration that varied in inconvenience to residents and improved efficiency for service delivery. Consensus was reached to support least inconvenient changes to code and present to council, and willing to reassess after the year.

Streets, Alleys, and Sidewalks - *Hadley, Neal, Johnson, Schissel

Review issues related to streets, sidewalks alleys and other concerns related to the street department. Reviews plans for the growth, improvement, and maintenance of the street system including capital improvements programming, annual projects and requests. Street related improvements generally include those whose construction, acquisition or maintenance costs may be funded with Road Use Tax (RUT) funds and / or Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) revenues.
