ALL TREES MUST BE SINGLE STEM AND THORNLESS

Small Ornamental Trees

(Approved for Planting Under Power Lines)

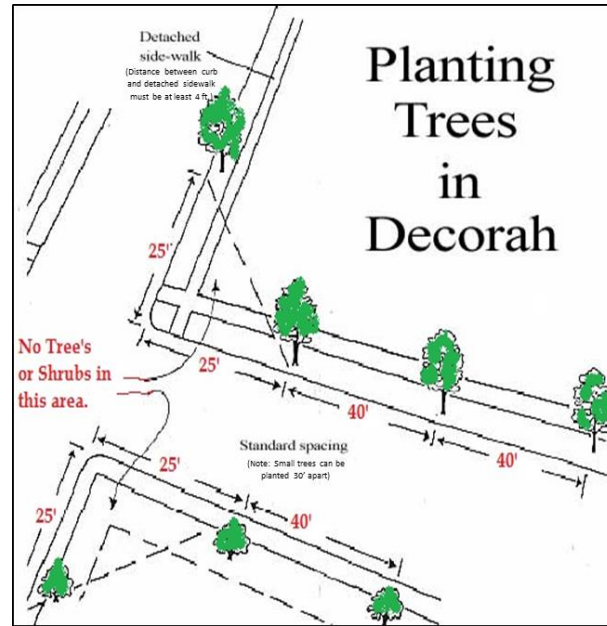
- Blue-beech (*Carpinus caroliniana*)
- Ironwood (*Ostrya virginiana*)
- Amur Chokecherry (*Prunus maackii*)
- Cockspur Hawthorn (*Crataegus crus-galli*)- thornless only
- Crabapples (*Malus sp.*) - upright & disease resistant varieties
- Japanese Tree Lilac (*Syringa reticulata*)
- Magnolia (*Magnolia sp.*)- under 35' tall only
- Plum 'Princess Kay' (*Prunus nigra* 'Princess Kay')
- Red Bud (*Cercis canadensis*)
- Serviceberry (*Amelanchier x grandiflora*)- single stem only

Large Shade Trees

- River Birch (*Betula nigra*)- single stem only
- Swamp White Oak (*Quercus bicolor*)
- Amur Corktree (*Phellodendron amurense*)- male/ fruitless only
- Honey Locust (*Gleditsia triacanthos*)- thornless and seedless only
- Kentucky Coffee (*Gymnocladus dioica*)- seedless only
- Elm (*Ulmus sp.*)- disease resistant only
- Ginkgo (*Ginkgo biloba*)- seedless only
- Hackberry (*Celtis occidentalis*)
- Chinkapin Oak (*Quercus muhlenbergii*)
- Cucumber Magnolia (*Magnolia acuminata*)
- Yellowwood (*Cladrastis kentukea*)
- Tuliptree (*Liriodendron tulipifera*)

Important Information for Property Owners

(Decorah City Code 12.40)

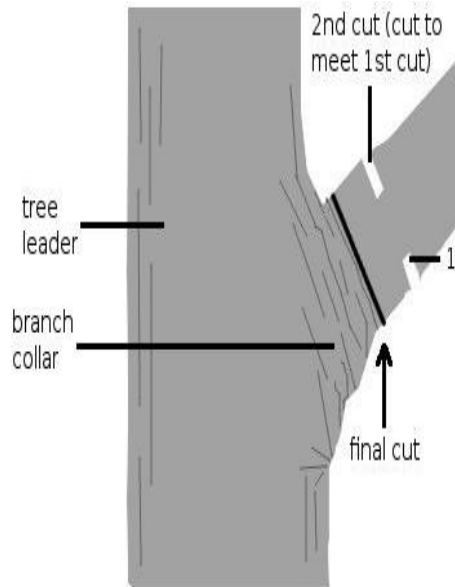
- Obtain a permit from City Hall before doing any work on a tree in the boulevard/ right-of-way.
- Trim trees to a minimum clearance of 8' over sidewalks and 14' over streets.
- Trim or remove any vegetation encroaching into an alley abutting private property.
- Plant shade trees at least 40' apart and ornamentals at least 30' apart on the boulevard/ right-of-way.
- Do not plant shade trees or ornamentals within 25' of an intersection, 4' of an alley, or 6' of a driveway.
- Plant in the center of the right-of-way and no closer than thirty (30) inches from the back of the curb.
- Maintain the health of trees so they do not create a hazard to other trees, vehicles, pedestrians, or property.

Don't forget to submit your Right-of-Way permit to City Hall.

Tree Planting Checklist

- **Obtain permit.** Contact your City Forester to ensure all City Codes are followed.
- **Be sure it is safe to dig.** Contact Iowa One Call at 1-800-292-8989 or online at www.iowaonecall.com.
- **Research options.** Decide what species, size, and location works for your property.
- **Plant new tree.** Follow the tree diagram below for planting guidelines.
- **Follow up with tree health.** Water, mulch, stake (only if needed), and prune regularly to ensure the long life of your tree.

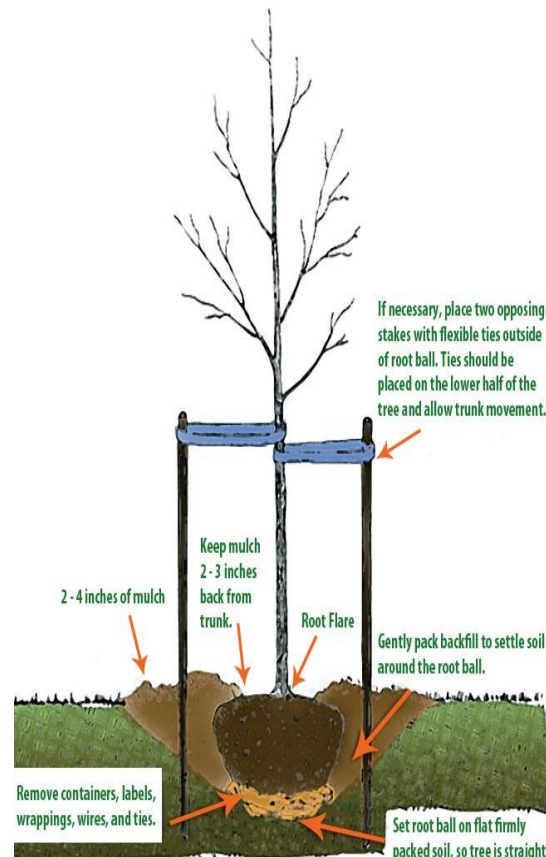

3. *Follow the proper planting checklist to ensure healthy tree.*

The City of Decorah will contribute **\$60.00** per tree (limit two trees per property per year).
